

VOTE NO PROP 1

There's a better way to get the Walkways and Park Improvements we need without a **PERMANENT 61%** LFP property tax increase.

PROP 1 IS... PERMANENT

Prop 1's proposed increase goes on forever. The City Council could have funded these improvements with a term limit, but chose not to.

EXCESSIVE

Prop 1 is the largest tax increase ever proposed in the history of LFP. It will disproportionately penalize young families and people on fixed incomes.

RESTRICTIVE

Prop 1 funds would represent 38% of our property tax revenue—all to be spent on parks and safe streets. This limits our ability to address evolving needs and priorities (without another tax increase).

NO CLEAR PLAN

The City's current plans and reports do NOT define specific project details, costs, or priorities—this info will only be developed AFTER Prop 1 passes—with NO requirement for public input.

LOSS OF CONTROL

Prop 1 lacks transparency, accountability, and effective controls. There is no process for community review and approval.



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Our city needs safer streets, walkways, and park improvements. **VOTE NO ON PROP 1** to tell City Council to address these needs with a more affordable, effective, and responsible approach:



USE TIME-LIMITED FUNDING

Fund these efforts responsibly—in the same or less time—with term/time-limited or project-specific financing.



MAKE IT AFFORDABLE

Reduce the taxpayer share of funding. Seek grants, use federal, state, county and other funding sources.



KEEP THE BUDGET FLEXIBLE

Ensure our City remains financially agile to address new issues, priorities, and emergencies as they arise.



CREATE A DETAILED PLAN

Require a clear plan reflecting community priorities and acceptable funding levels.



INCLUDE ACCOUNTABILITY

Provide appropriate controls, monitoring, and routine approval milestones for citizens.
